

How to add the Digital Health information site on your desktop/laptop/WOW

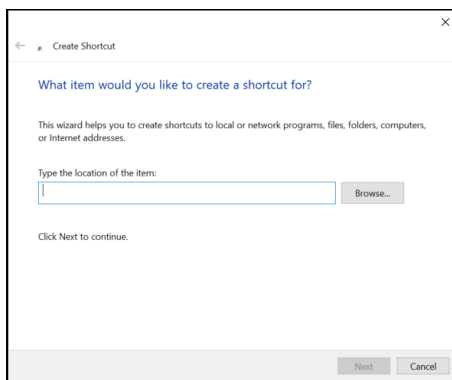

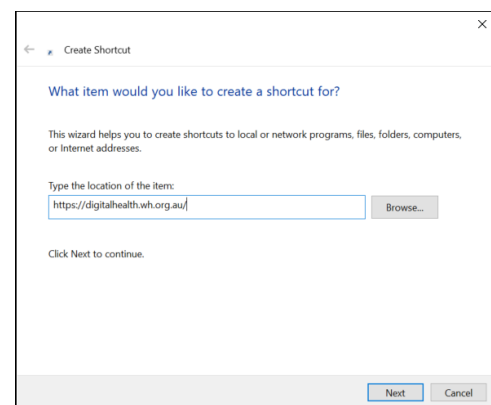
Everyone who will be using the EMR should create a shortcut to access the site easily

1. Right click on your desktop and scroll down to 'New'. Then click on shortcut.

2. You will see this screen



3. Type in the location <https://digitalhealth.wh.org.au/>
Click **Next**



4. Rename the shortcut to 'Digital Health information site' and click **Finish** to create the shortcut

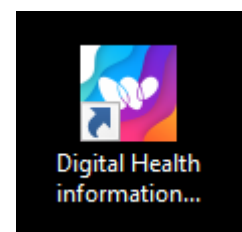

5. The icon will now appear on your desktop/laptop screen and you can click through at any time

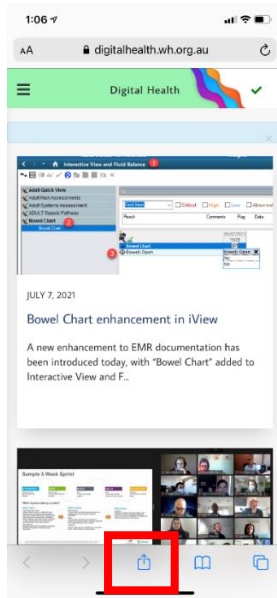




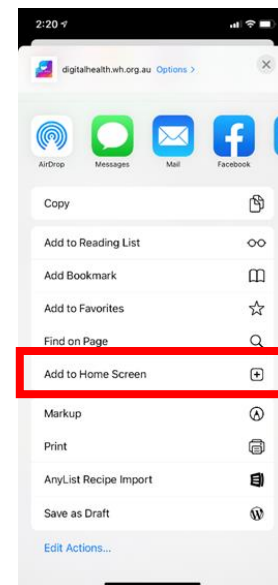
How to add the Digital Health information site on your iPhone

1. Type digitalhealth.wh.org.au into the address bar on your iPhone's browser.

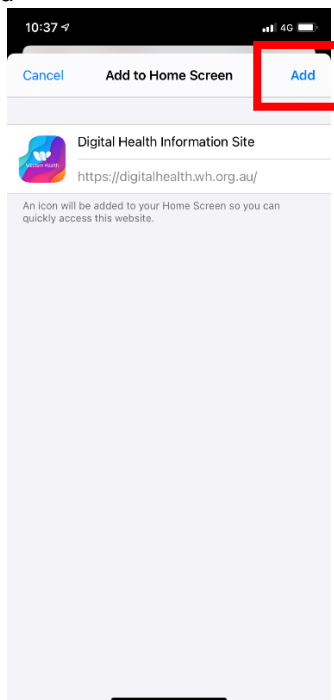
2. The site will come up. Click on the button in the middle of the base of the screen



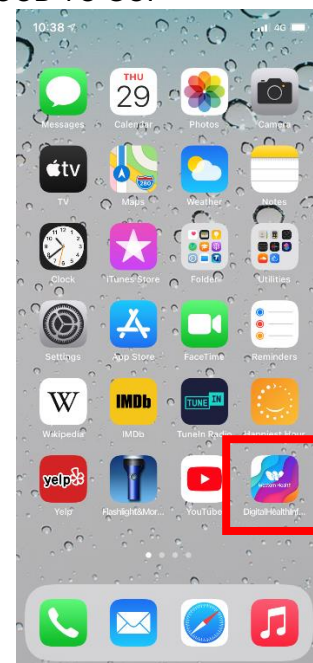
3. Click on 'Add to home screen'



4. Click on Add

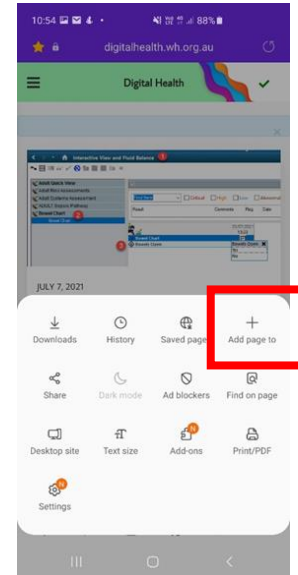
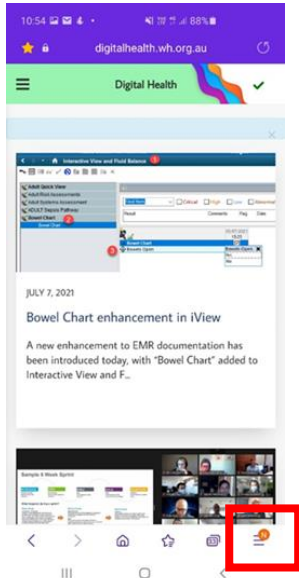


5. The icon will appear on your home screen – YOU'RE GOOD TO GO!

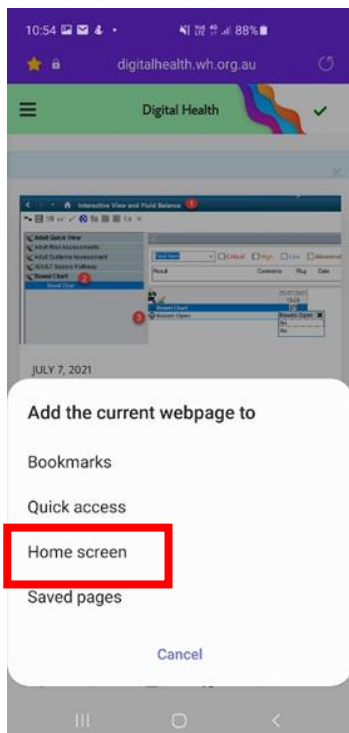


How to add the Digital Health information site on your Android phone

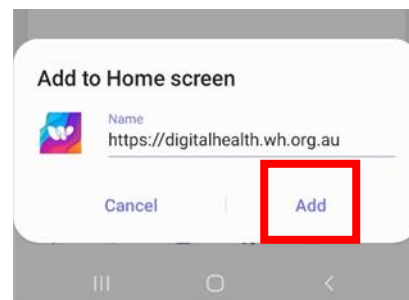
1. Type digitalhealth.wh.org.au into the address bar on your phone's browser.
2. Click on the three lines in the corner
3. Click on 'Add page to'
