



## EMR Quick Reference Guide

### Administration - PBS Eligibility Status Field

Based on a patient's Medicare, DVA entitlements and administrative category recorded in iPM will determine the PBS Eligibility Status of PBS or NON-PBS discharge medications

The eligibility status must be correct prior to creation of a discharge prescription. A prescription is unable to be amended so a new prescription will require completion if eligibility status requires a change.

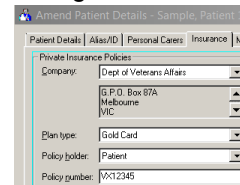
- To view eligibility status go to Power Chart. Select 'Patient information' in Table of Contents. Select Demographics tab.



- The eligibility status is displayed based on the following patient information integrated from iPM:-

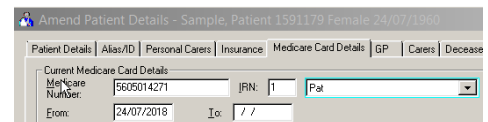

Patient Details screen, Insurance tab



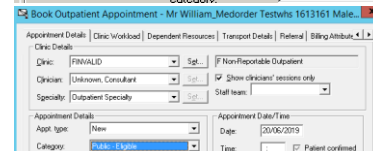
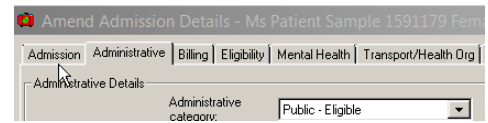
- Medicare**

- The eligibility status is computed in the following sequence:-

- DVA (Gold, White or Other DVA Entitlement)
- Medicare No. or suffix P-N
- Medicare suffix C-U or N-E
- Medicare suffix N-E **plus** Administrative Category Public-Reciprocal HCA
- Medicare suffix N-E **plus** Administrative Category any except Public- Reciprocal HCA
