



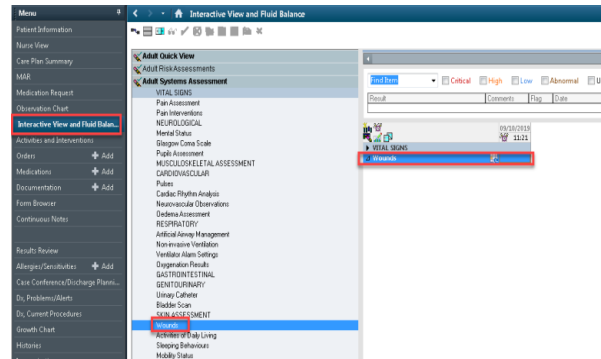
EMR Quick Reference Guide

Clinical Care – Completing a Wound Chart and Ordering Ongoing Wound Care

1. Completing a Wound Chart:

To complete a wound chart documentation go to:

- **Interactive View and Fluid Balance** from Table of Contents
- Choose the **Adult Systems Assessment** band
- Select **Wound:**



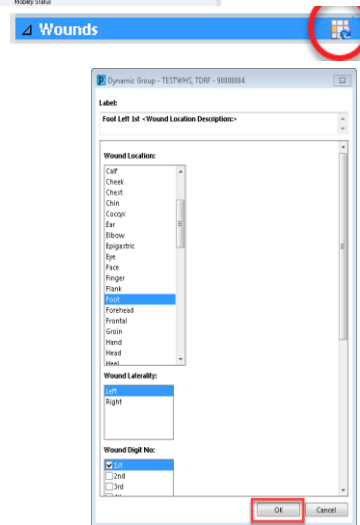
- Set up your wound via the **Dynamic Group** icon
- Click on **Dynamic Group** icon
- Dynamic Group window will open
- To accurately describe your wound/s Complete :
 - **Wound Location.**
 - **Wound Laterality.**
 - **Wound Digit No** (if required).
 - **Wound Location Description.**

- Each individual wound must be created via the **Dynamic group** icon.
- When this is completed click **OK**.
- Your wound description will appear in **Interactive View**



- Complete the wound chart by clicking through the chart and entering the relevant information about the wound:
 - In **Activity** identify if the wound is new or present on admission.
 - Identify **Wound Type**.

Note: Each wound must have information describing the wound base with **every** dressing change.

- The **wound dimensions** must also be documented at every dressing change

- When documentation complete click on the **Green Tick** to save information, the entered data will turn from purple to black

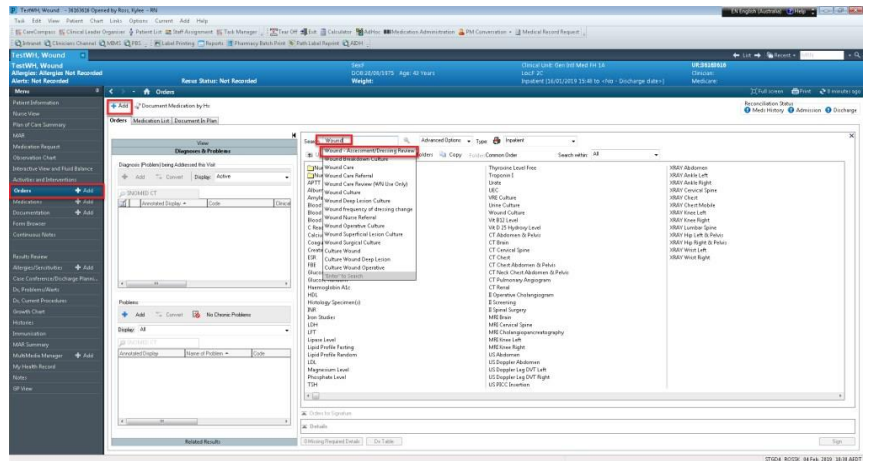


Note: If the patient has multiple wounds then a **Dynamic Group** is to be set up for **each one**.

2. Ordering Ongoing Wound Care:

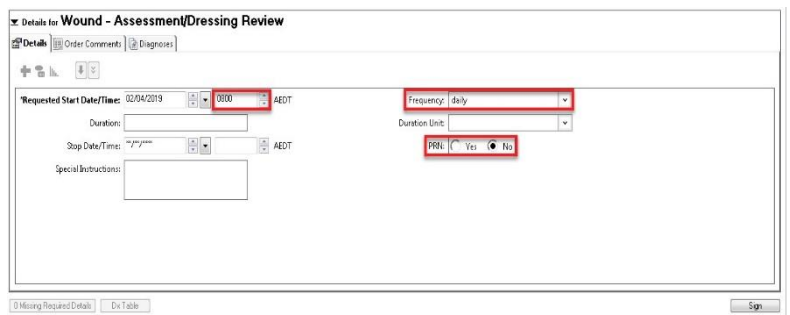
When documentation is complete an order must be placed for **Each** wound to guide ongoing continuity of wound care. Note: one order can be completed **if** multiple wounds have the same frequency.

- Select **Orders** from Table of Contents
- Click on **+Add**
- In search box type in **wound**
- Select **Wound Assessment/Dressing Review** from the drop down menu and the **Order** window will open.



To fill in the **Wound – Assessment/Dressing Review**:

- Change the **requested date/time** to **0800** (this will then alert the staff member at beginning of the AM shift that the dressing is due).
- Select **Frequency** from the drop down menu.
- Select **NO** from the **PRN** section



Click on the **Order Comments** tab to add details and special instructions and then **Sign** to complete the order:



Important Note: if entering multiple orders, complete all orders before signing.

- The Signed orders will appear in the **Orders** screen under **Patient Care** as *Processing*.
- Refresh the page and the order status will change to *Ordered*.
- The Order will drop a task, daily at 0800hrs, on the **Activity page** on **Care Compass**. Only sign the task in **Care Compass** after it has been completed.
