



EMR Quick Reference Guide

Medications - Administering Antimicrobials (Restricted and Highly Restricted)

Key Messages:

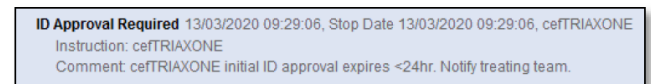
- **3 separate Nursing/Pharmacy shared tasks:** to ensure the **Treating Team** is notified that ID approval is about to, or has expired – Refer Doctor to their Task Manager as they will have also received a message
- Once a task is marked as **'done'** by either nursing or pharmacy, the task is removed from Care Compass and Pharmacy Care Organiser
- Restricted antimicrobial orders without ID approval, automatically expires 72 hours after first dose
- Orders with ID approval expire at 7.30 AM on the **specified date** (visible on MAW and MAR)
ID Approval Exp (7:30AM): 11/03/2020,
- Administration is blocked after approval has expired

Nursing - On administration the following alerts will fire and tasks placed in Care Compass if:

1. Initial approval expires in < 24 hours:



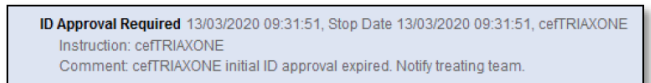
Administration can continue until expiry



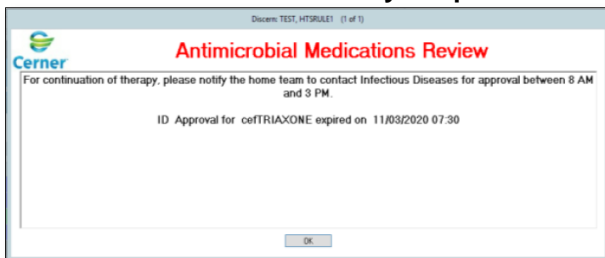
2. Initial approval has expired (>72 hours):



Administration is blocked



3. It is after 7:30 AM on the day of specified ID approval expiry



Administration is blocked



Pharmacy: same tasks as above in PCO and Activities and Interventions
