





EMR Quick Reference Guide

Pharmacy – Pharmacy Clinical Intervention (Pharmacist Use)

The Pharmacy Clinical Intervention Powerform is used to document all Medication Related Problems to be reviewed. This does **not** replace the paging system or verbal communication.



1. Click on 
2. Search for and select “R/V Pharmacy Intervention – Dr Order (See Pharmacist Clinical Intervention form)”.
Note: order with grey order sentence must be chosen.
3. Complete all mandatory fields, i.e. Service (Clinical Unit), Priority, and Clinician Callback Number (Pharmacist’s pager number).


4. Click  and enter Username and Password to submit the order.

6. Click on  and the ‘Rx Interventions’ tab.

7. Double click on the task to launch the Pharmacy Clinical Intervention Form.

8. Complete all necessary fields.

9. Click on the Save Form icon .
Do **NOT** click on the Sign Form icon  as this will complete the intervention, i.e. the problem has been resolved with ‘Task Status = Complete’
Saving the form will show ‘Task Status = In Process’

10. When the intervention has been addressed by the Clinical Unit, the form can be opened by Pharmacy to document the team’s action in Prescriber Response (if it has not already done). Click on the  to mark the intervention as complete.
