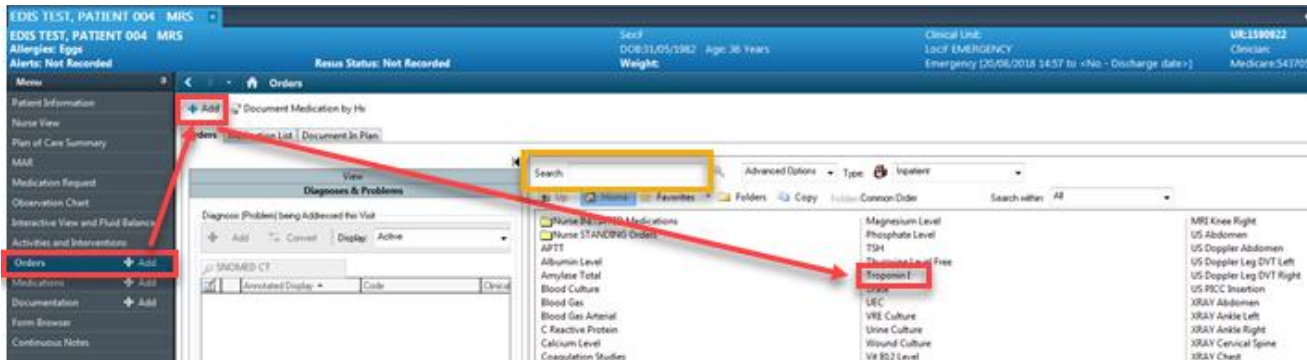


EMR Quick Reference Guide

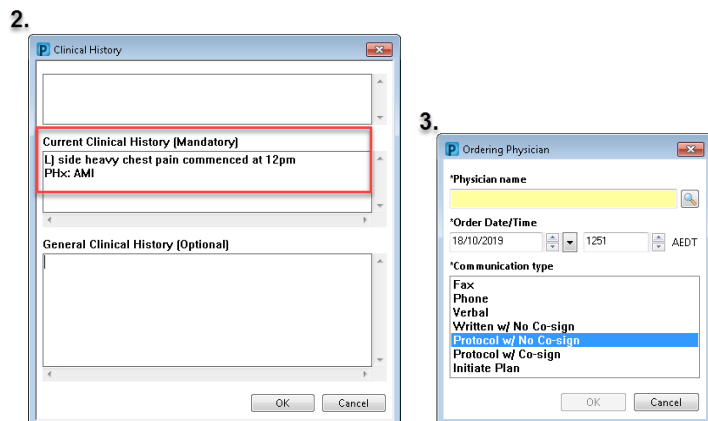
ED - Nurse Initiated Pathology Order

1. Navigate to **Orders** in the patients EMR Powerchart. Select the **+Add** and select pathology orders required or enter in the pathology orders in the search engine. You can order multiple pathology orders as required.




2. Complete the **Clinical History** field and click **OK**.
3. The ordering physician window will appear. Enter in the consultant in charge of the shift. Select **Protocol w/ No Co-sign**. Click **OK**.

Note: it is important to select the **No Co-sign** option to avoid creating unnecessary tasks for the doctor that you nominate to cosign your request.




4. Proceed to complete the details of the pathology order. All yellow fields are mandatory. Select the collection priority as **Collect Now**.
