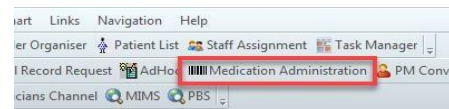

2. Print wristbands (as needed) via label printing

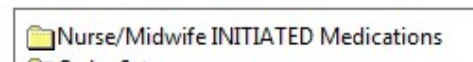

5. **Document** lines and devices e.g. IVC, IDC, etc
