




EMR Quick Reference Guide

ED - Interim Admission Adult


The ED Adult Interim Admission is the new replacement for previous paper based '4h plans'. This serves as a basic communication tool for staff as patients transition from ED to the ward whilst awaiting a formal admission by the receiving team. The relevant procedure guideline can be found from the Western Health intranet.

 This is performed by the ED medical officer & only after referral to the admitting team

1. Select the patient on EMR and navigate to 'orders' from the table of contents

2. Search for the order set "ED Adult Interim Admission (4 hour Plan)" and select it

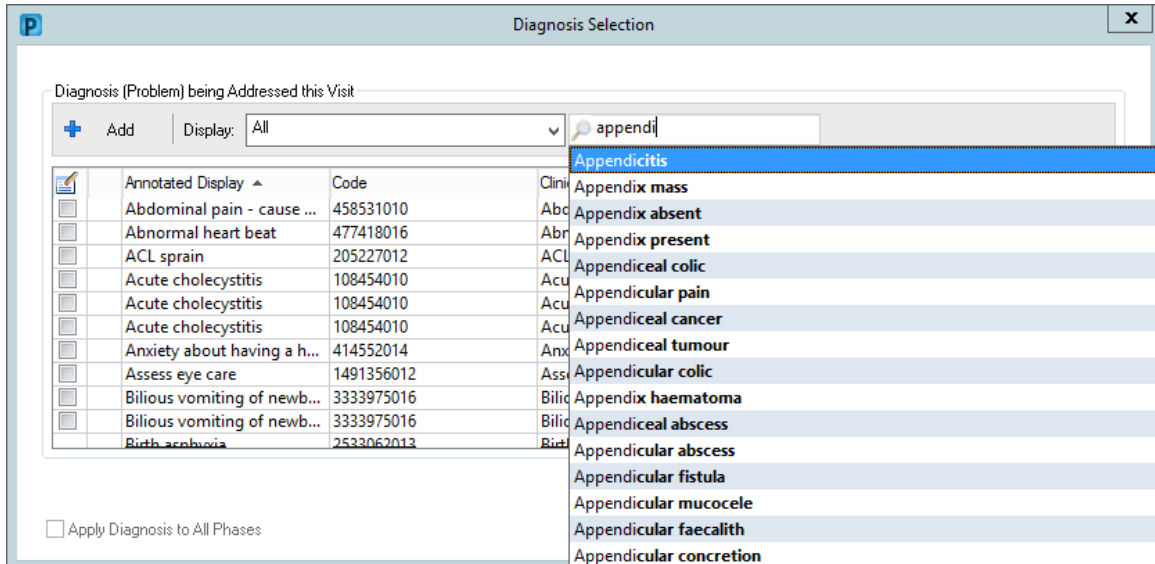

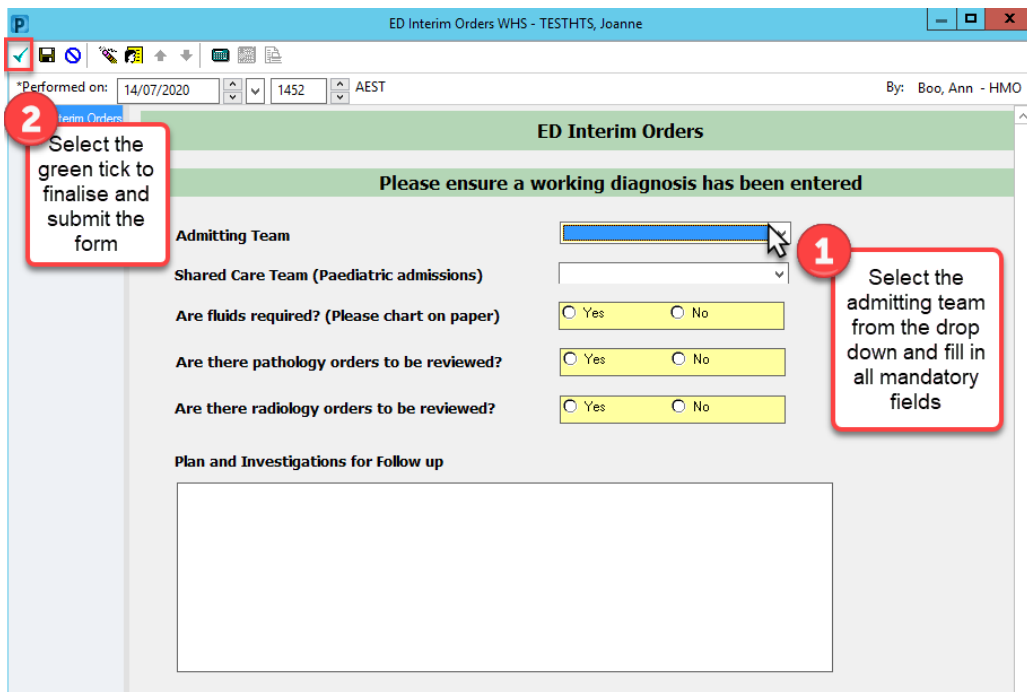
6. Type in and/or search for the current most appropriate diagnosis for the patient
