## Important – Contact your Super Users for access



To access the EMR Practice Environment, you must be within the Western Health network or using a Western Health device. You cannot access the EMR Practice Environment from home/offsite using a personal device.

You can use the role specific Username and Password provided to EMR Super Users in your area. If you would like to access the Practice Environment whilst completing WeLearn packages, use role specific logins and dedicated patients listed on page 2.

2. Enter your own **Username** and **Password** – the login details you use to access your Western Health emails
