

### View Alerts in EMR

- Alerts are displayed as either '**Recorded**' or '**Not Recorded**' in the blue banner bar as seen here
- To view alert, click on '**Dx, Problems/Alerts**' from Table of Contents (TOC)
- Alerts are displayed under '**Problems**'





### View Historical Alerts in iPM

- Right click on the **Patient ID**, hover over Patient and left click on **Patient Alerts**.



- The Alert may have already been moved to EMR in which case this alert would have an end date and a comment advising **Alert Moved to EMR**.





## Add an Infectious alert on EMR

6. If the Alert has not been moved to EMR, you must add this alert.
7. Click on '**Dx, Problems/Alerts**' from the Table of Contents (TOC)
8. Click on **+Add** under '**Problems**' to add an alert as seen here 
9. Select **Folders** and click on **Common Alerts**.
10. Select **Infectious Risk** folder
11. Choose the infectious risk alert by double clicking on it.
12. This will then display on the Problems window. Complete the information and select OK to save it.
