

Allergies –Review, Modify and Cancel



This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

View, mark as reviewed, modify or cancel an allergy in EMR

View

Click on **Allergies/Sensitivities** under the Table of Contents (TOC) to view the recorded allergy(s).

Allergies/Sensitivities + Add

Review

1. Verbally confirm any documented allergies (or no known allergies) with the patient. Verify by clicking **Mark All as Reviewed**.
2. Refresh to update the Reviewed date and time column.
