




This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to: document a COVID-19 diagnosis


- If a patient tests positive for COVID-19, a diagnosis should be added to the patient's chart.

Steps


1. Select **Dx Problems/Alerts** from the Navigation bar



2. Under **Diagnosis (Problem)**, select **+Add**



3. Type the diagnosis into the yellow field and click the binoculars to view a list of options with **SNOMED codes**



4. Select the appropriate diagnosis and click **OK**



- Click the drop-down list next to **Type** and select one of **Principal Dx, Additional Dx, Complication**
