

Communicate and order newborn feeding plans

Definitions:

Quick Orders – a feature that allows healthcare professionals to quickly select and order commonly used tests, medications, or procedures for a patient. It is designed to streamline the order entry process and improve efficiency in healthcare settings.

Placing Newborn Feed Plan order

1. From the Neonatology Quick Orders mPage > Patient care orders > Diet > Neonatal feed plan
2. Complete the **Special Instructions** Order Entry Field (OEF) as appropriate for the patient. This is a free text OEF to enable text to communicate the specifics of the feed plan. Breakdown of fluid type, additives, frequency and route should be communicated here as required.



3. This can be viewed from the order profile section of **Admit/Manage mPage** for medical or the **Workflow mPage** for nursing



Important

- Review the Dosing weight and fluid goals section prior to placing this order
- For demand/single source of nutrition patients, nursing team will place this order
- For complex feeding regimes, medical team will place this order to communicate to the nursing team
