
This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

It can also be customised by the user to display only the columns that are relevant for their ward/area. 

- Select layout configuration b)
- c) Select or deselect columns to customise this to your ward/area
- d) Click the 6 dots and drag to rearrange columns
- Click on Rows e)
- f) Select the radio button next to 5 (this will display all rows of patient demographics)
- g) Click Apply
