## This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Order, document and discontinue Portable Video Monitoring in the EMR.

### Definitions:

**Portable Video Monitoring** – An evidence-based falls prevention strategy extending observation to monitor patients with a high risk of falls

**Orders and Referrals** – A page within Powerchart used to view, add, complete and discontinue orders.

**PowerForms** – Form-based documentation used in Powerchart.

**Care Compass** - A dashboard view of a patient's chart with relevant activities mapped over time used by Nursing or patient assigned in their care.

## Order Portable Video Monitoring

1. Navigate to **Orders and Referrals** from the Table of Contents and click **+Add**.
2. Search and select **Portable Video Monitoring**.

Patient Consent

As part of obtaining initial consent, communicate the following key points to the patient or representative:

- Discuss that Patient has been assessed as high risk for a fall and explain patient factors contributing to risk rating.
- Advice of the additional individualised falls prevention strategies in place.
- Clarify that video monitoring is live and cannot be recorded.
- Explain Frequency and Duration of video monitoring.
- Explain that the monitor is not continuously observed.
- Explain that evidence shows that video monitoring is a helpful strategy used to reduce the risk of a fall overnight.
- Offer Patient Information Sheet if NOK/patient would like further details.
- Document in Nursing Notes if patient or NOK/patient representative Do Not Consent to the use of patient video monitoring.

If the patient is unable to consent, enter the name of Next of Kin or Key Representative.





## Enter Order Information in the Order Entry Window

1. Enter relevant order details i.e Requested Start Date and Time, Frequency, Duration, Duration Unit, Stop Date and Time.
2. Click **Sign** and enter Password.
3. Click **Refresh**. Portable Video Monitoring will appear with the status Ordered in the **Orders and Referrals** page.



## Document Portable Video Monitoring

1. Navigate to **Care Compass** from the main toolbar at the top of the page
2. Search for Portable Video Monitoring in the **Activities** tab or **PRN/Continuous** tab.
  - Note: Task in Activities tab will only appear if it is due within 2, 4 or 12 hours.
3. Click **Document**.
4. Complete relevant **Interactive View** data.
5. Click the  icon to Sign.





## Discontinue Portable Video Monitoring

1. Navigate to **Orders and Referrals**.
2. Find the Portable Video Monitoring order. This will appear under the **Patient Care** category.
3. Right click on the order and select **Cancel/DC**.
4. Select **Discontinue Reason**.
5. Click **Orders for Signature** and **Sign**.
6. Enter Password and click OK.
7. Portable Video Monitoring Status will appear with a Discontinued status in the **Orders and Referrals** page.
