

# FirstNet – Clerical - ED to Inpatient Admission



## This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Manage a patient that requires admission from the Emergency Department to an inpatient ward.

- To identify the current bed requests for the department, go to **ED Admin Tab** and select the **All Bed Requests** filter.

Bed Requests can also be identified by the red and yellow dots on the tracking board.

- The red dot indicates a bed request that has not been allocated a bed.
- The yellow dot indicates a bed request that has been allocated a bed.

- The requested specialty and bed type displays on the tracking board columns.

- Once you have identified a new bed request and determined the requested specialty, go to **iPM** and admit the patient to the holding ward associated with the campus you are working at (*S Emergency or F Emergency*). Ensure you select the patient's correct compensable status.
- Look up the patient's encounters with the FirstNet search box. Confirm that Single Encounter Logic has worked. The Visit No will display with an IPE number in brackets.

Note: If another encounter opens, Single Encounter Logic has not worked, please check the iPM admission has been completed correctly.

- Print new labels from iPM and replace any existing labels.
- Once admitted on iPM, write a comment in the clerk comment box to indicate that the patient has been admitted on iPM.

The patient will now wait for a bed to be allocated.

- Once the patient has been allocated a bed, the red dot will turn yellow, indicating that the bed request has been allocated. The patient will now sit under the **All Beds Assigned/Ready** filter.

- Ensure all labels are replaced with the new labels associated with the requested specialty.

- Page the PSA to initiate the transfer.

- In FirstNet, right click on the patient's name and select **Admit to Wards/SSU**

- The ED Admit window will display. Enter the appropriate **Depart Disposition**, **Inpatient Admit Date** and **Inpatient Admit Time**. Ensure you take note of the Inpatient Admit Date and Inpatient Admit Time as you will match this date and time in iPM. Click **Complete**.
