

FirstNet - Clerical - Moving a Patient



This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Move a patient in FirstNet, updating the bed field.

1. Double click on the current **bed field** against the patient you want to move.

2. Select a location for ...box will appear. Select the bed you want patient to go to. NOTE the number within () indicates the number of patients within the location.

3. Select new bed location and Click ok.
