

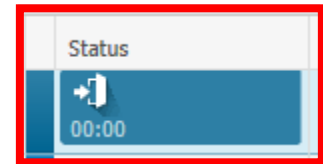
FirstNet - ED Nursing Discharge Documentation



This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Complete nursing documentation for patients being discharged from ED.

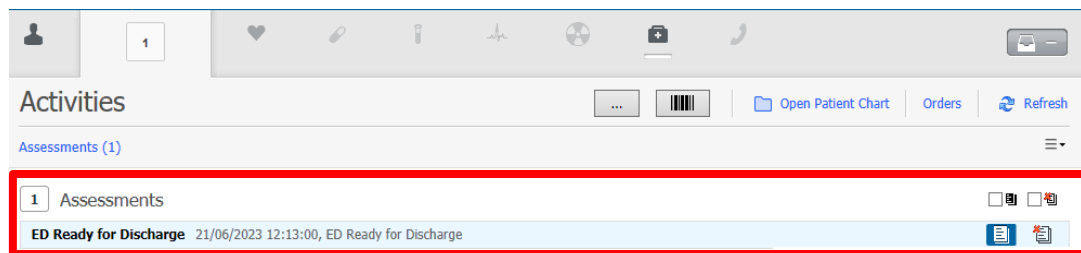
1. When a patient is ready for discharge, the status will change on LaunchPoint. It will display blue with a door icon. The timer starts once the decision to discharge is made by the **Treating Doctor**.



2. A nursing task will display in the nursing activities column. Click on the '1' to view activities.



3. Select the assessment task by clicking on it (highlights blue) and then select 'Document'.



4. The ED Discharge iView documentation section will open. Select yes if the patient has valuables and belongings. You can then document that the valuables have been returned.

Note: all discharge fields are to be documented and the IVC field is mandatory.

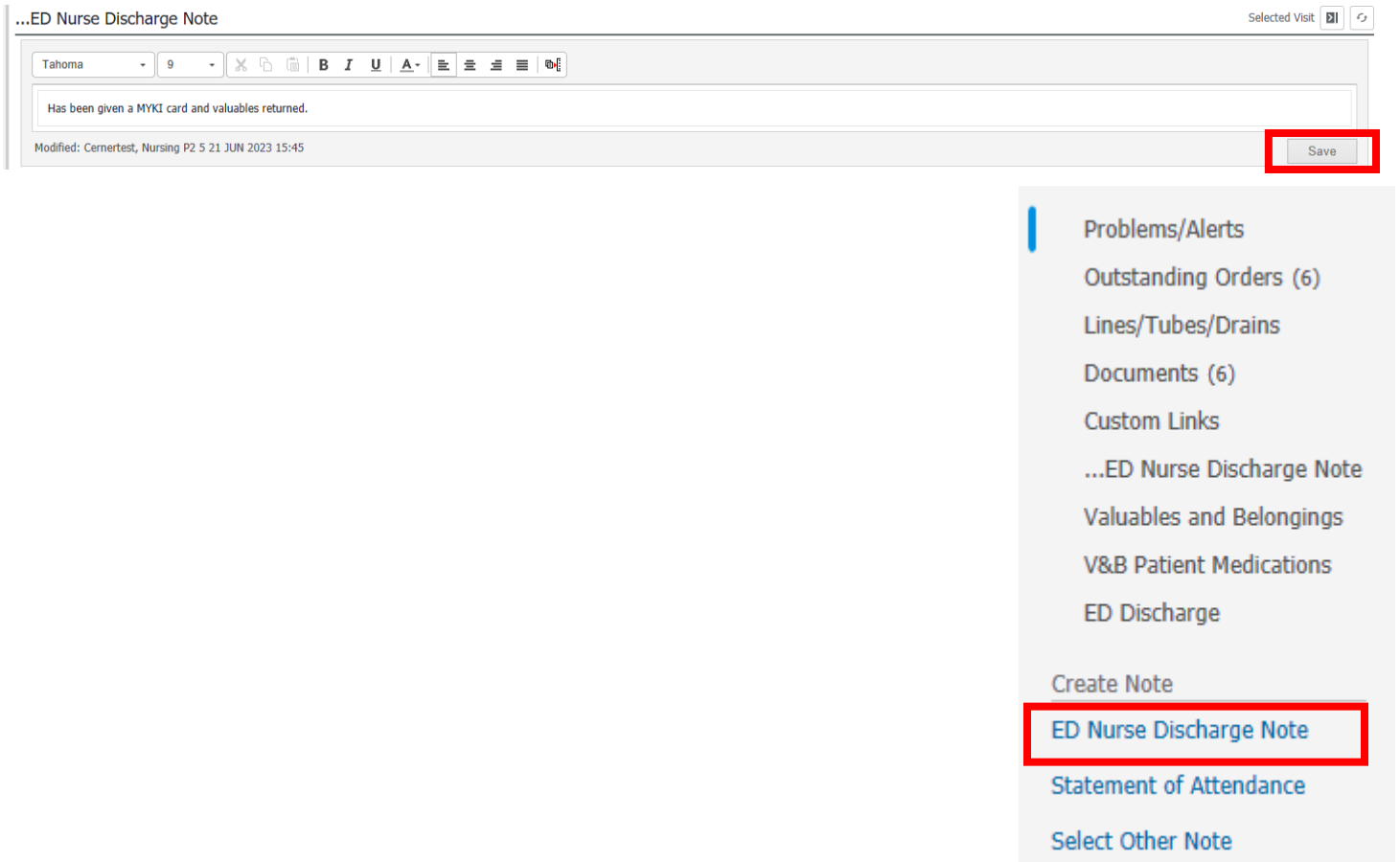

Clicking 'Save' on this box and then create the note via the blue hyperlink 'ED Nurse Discharge Note'. Ensure to **sign and submit** your ED Nurse Discharge Note.



7. The patient is now ready for discharge and all nursing tasks and documentation is completed.
