

# FirstNet LaunchPoint Alerts and Icons



## This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Understand common alerts on LaunchPoint. This QRG applies to any ED clinician working in LaunchPoint.

### Overview:

**High Alerts** - They display in the room column. Will turn the room box red and name the alert/event. Only one will show face up at a time (hierarchy), more than one high alert will display when hovering over room.

**Set Events** - Small icons that appear in patient information section. You can click on some for more information. They can be clinical alerts/information eg management plan as care notes.

**Infectious Alert**

- HR Risk COVID will display for ED Isolation

**High Alert**

- BOC
  - Display automatically with BOC >2
- Must Stay
- No Visitors

- To manually place a High Alert or Patient Icon on a patient. **Right click** on the patient row and select **'Request Event'**. Select the event you wish to start.
- To remove or complete out a High Alert/Patient Icon. Right click on the patient name and select **'Complete Event'**.

**Important**

- Alerts identify risks associated with patients, ranging from infectious, allergies or BOC/Security risk. This serves as an early flag to investigate or manage the patient accordingly.
- Any alert added to the patient encounter that displays as the red triangle will stay with the patient until it is cancelled (across encounters/presentations)
