1. On Tracking Board, click on **rocket icon** to search for a patient. OR on LaunchPoint, select the '**ED Patient Identification**'

- 5. In the **sex** field select **male** or **female** and tab across the last name will automatically display as unknown and first name will display 'six' with letters.
- 6. Type in an estimated **Date of Birth**.
- 7. Complete the arrival transport mode field.
- 8. Click OK
