

Infusions – TPN Ward Round – Medical, Pharmacy and Dietetics



REFERRAL

To refer a patient to the TPN ward round, place a TPN referral via the **Orders and Referrals** page after verbal consultation.

MULTIPATIENT TASKLIST

The list of all patients on the TPN ward round is located under the TPN tab of the **Multipatient Tasklist (MPTL)**. This is visible for Pharmacists, Doctors and Dietitians.

- List can be created in **Patient List** clicking on
 - Location: Select relevant **campus(es)**
 - Encounter: Inpatient
 - Discharged criteria: Not discharged
 - Name List: Example – ‘Sunshine TPN’ or as appropriate

- Whilst on the TPN tab, right click on and click on **Assigned Tasks** and click on ‘**Customize Patient View..**’

- Click on **Choose a Patient List**

- Select list created above
- Review date range

Note: for active TPN referrals to display here the initial TPN referral must have been ordered within this date range.

To provide handover via the MPTL, right click on the patient and select “**Create Admin Note**”. Document handover and click **OK**.

The presence of an admin note is denoted by the icon below. To open and modify the note, double click the icon.

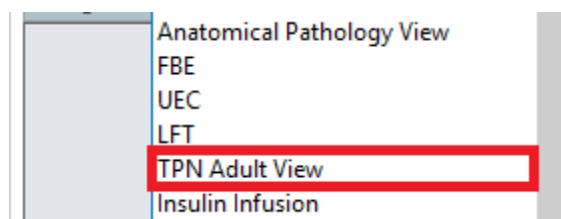
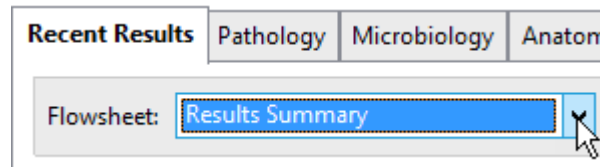


RESULTS REVIEW

Results Review is a spreadsheet of results. There is a **TPN Flowsheet** which has a collection of patient results and assessments relevant to TPN. This includes: All TPN and Nutritional bloods, Gastrointestinal assessment, BGL and food charts.



Navigate to **Results Review** and select **TPN Adult View** from the Flowsheet drop down list.



DOCUMENTATION

Review the Dietitian recommendations via the Nutrition Assessment or Progress Note.
