

- The Orders window display with the Nurse/Midwife Initiated
 Medications folder first on the left column. Select this folder.
- Select from the three available folders for either Adult, Paediatric or Neonatal patients.
- Click once on the folder to open. A list of medications a nurse/midwife can order with no cosign will display.


