- From the Table of Contents (TOC), select Interactive View and Fluid Balance (iView) page.
- 2. Select Adult Systems Assessment band
- Under VITAL SIGNS section, document the orthostatic blood pressure


Note: if you cannot find SBP/DBP
Supine/Sitting/Standing fields, Look up Access and Set
Up - Customising Interactive View and Fluid Balance
(iView) QRG to add it to iView.

- From the TOC, select Observation Chart and Refresh
- Go to the Blood Pressure Header and click on Orthostatic
- Tick/Untick the options to filter which blood pressure to view



Hover over the observation point to view the blood pressure
