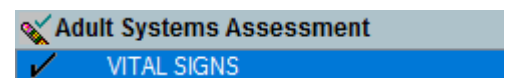

Documenting/Viewing Orthostatic Blood Pressure

1. From the **Table of Contents (TOC)**, select **Interactive View and Fluid Balance (iView)** page.

Interactive View and Fluid Balance

2. Select **Adult Systems Assessment** band
3. Under **VITAL SIGNS** section, document the orthostatic blood pressure



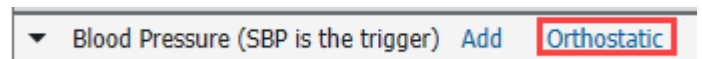
Note: if you cannot find SBP/DBP Supine/Sitting/Standing fields, Look up [Access and Set Up - Customising Interactive View and Fluid Balance \(iView\)](#) QRG to add it to iView.

SBP/DBP Supine	mmHg	120/80
SBP/DBP Sitting	mmHg	123/75
SBP/DBP Standing	mmHg	110/76

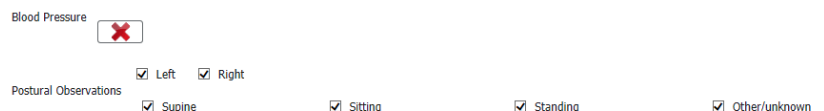
4. From the **TOC**, select **Observation Chart** and **Refresh**

Observation Chart

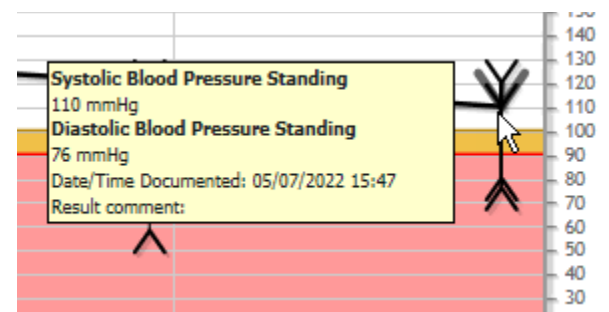
5. Go to the Blood Pressure Header and click on **Orthostatic**



6. Tick/Untick the options to filter which blood pressure to view



7. Hover over the observation point to view the blood pressure



8. Select the **red** cross to close the window
