Important

- EMR Paediatric Observation Charts will automatically default to the patient's age on admission.
- If the patient age increments to the next age group during admission, staff will need to manually change to the next observation chart age group if clinically appropriate
- Newborns who stay longer than 3 month and require a 3 to 12 month chart will need to change to the Paed

 3 to 12 Months (Long Stay) chart.

Changing Paediatric Observation Charts

1. Click on the **Chart Title** (e.g: Paed – 1 to 4 Years)
