

DPU – Day Procedure Unit


Ordering the PAC Insulin SUPPLEMENTAL Future Orderset PAC in Pre-Admission Clinic

The anaesthetist will place this orderset during Pre-admission Clinic (PAC) with the intention for it to be activated and administered in DPU on the day of the patient's procedure.

1. Search for and select *ANAES PAC Insulin SUPPLEMENTAL Future Orders* in Orders and Referrals



2. On the Add Plan window, enter the Estimated Start date (patient's expected procedure date)




3. Click OK

4. Ensure that the *Procedure Details*, *Communication Order* and *insulin* orders are selected in the appropriate weight category.
