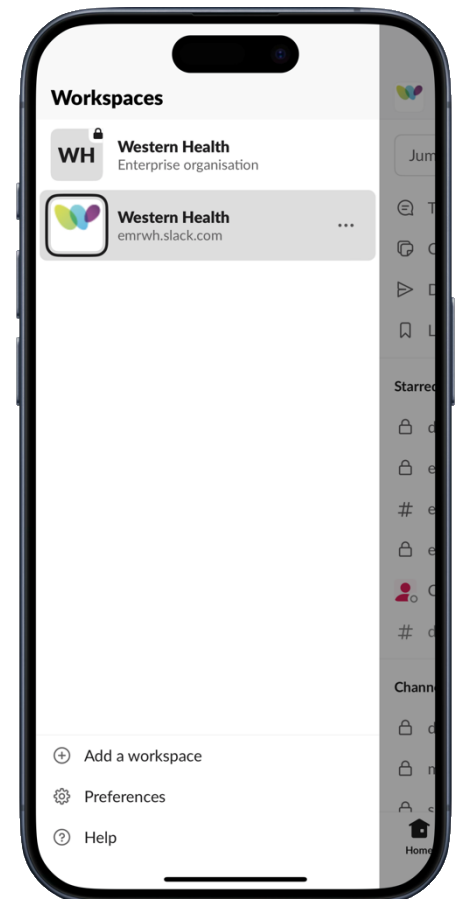
## Joining another workspace on Slack:

There are several Slack workspaces in use at Western Health. These include:

- Clinician workspace: [whclinicians.slack.com](https://whclinicians.slack.com)
- Digital Health workspace: [emrwh.slack.com](https://emrwh.slack.com)

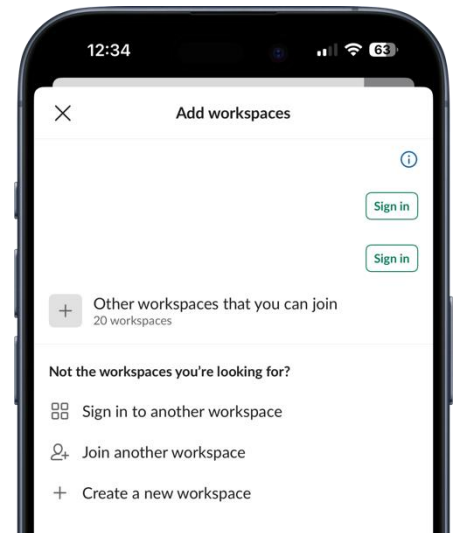
This guide will show you how to join a new workspace, if you are already a member of another workspace.

1. From  **Home**, tap the **workspace icon** in the top left corner, next to the workspace name.
2. Tap **Add a workspace**.

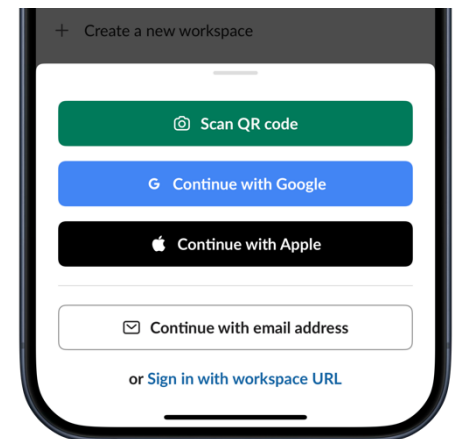




3. Tap  **Sign in to another workspace.**

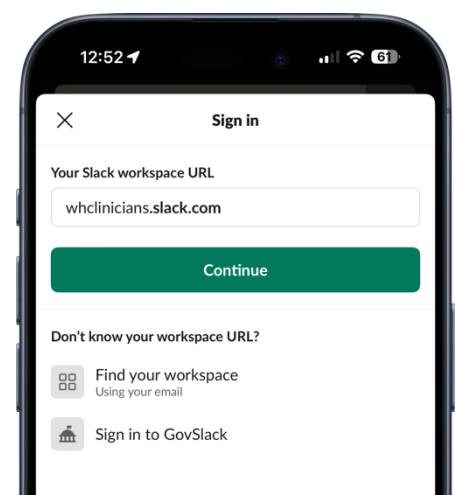


4. Select **Sign in with workspace URL** at the bottom of your screen.



5. Enter the new workspace's URL into the text field.  
**E.g. Clinician workspace: whclinicians.slack.com**

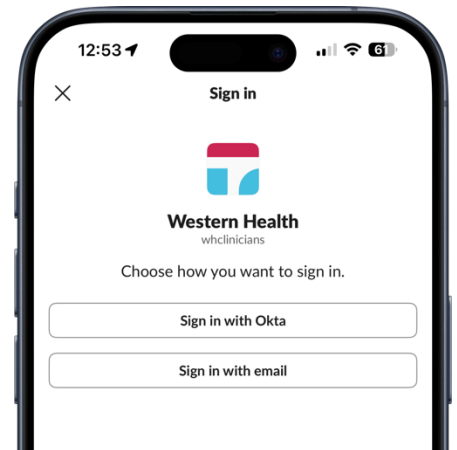
6. Tap **Continue**.



7. Tap **Sign in with Okta**.

8. Log in via Okta using your Western Health credential.

9. You have successfully added another workspace to Slack.



### Update 08 March 2024:

If you are joining the “whclinicians” workspace:

The application now displays “Western Health”, at the top, with the URL “wh.enterprise.slack.com”. This confirms you are in the correct “whclinicians” workspace.

This is correct and expected.

- Clinical communication must be conducted within the “whclinician” workspace for cybersecurity reason.
- Create private “**channels**” to communication within specialties, units, and groups.
- **Important:** Creating new workspaces for clinical communication is NOT endorsed by Western Health. All clinical communication must be kept within the “whclinicians” workspace.
