## Clinical Care – Completing the Community Adrenaline Auto-injector Checklist (Nursing staff)

- If a patient carries an Adrenaline Auto-injector in the community, it must be documented on EMR (via Problems/Alerts). This triggers an alert to prompt clinicians during each admission to ask about the auto-injector and manage accordingly
- 2. If the patient has **brought their own Adrenaline Auto-injector from home into hospital** the nursing checklist must be completed

1. Click on Dx, Problems/Alert from the Table of Contents (TOC)
