




WHERE DO I VIEW ALLERGIES AND ALERTS?

HOW DO I ADD ALERTS?

- On the **Dx. Problem/Alerts page**
- Click on **+ Add** in the Problems section




HOW DO I ADD ALLERGIES?

- In the **Table of Contents**
- Click on the **+ Add** next to **Allergies /Sensitivities**




- OR on the **Allergies/Sensitivities page** - click **+ Add**




HOW DO I REMOVE ALERTS?

- **Double click** on the Alert and update ***Status**

- On the **Allergies/Sensitivities page**
- Click on the relevant line and select **Cancel**

Patient Medication Orders - what's changing with EMR Phase 2.1?

The EMR will be used for the following medication orders:

• **Chemotherapy regimens**



- ONC CRC Adjuvant - CAPOX (XELOX)
- ONC CRC Adjuvant - de Gramont (12 cycles)
- ONC CRC Adjuvant - FOLFOX6 (8 cycles)
- ONC CRC Advanced, Metastatic/Recurrent - pembrolizumab 3 weekly (35 cycles)

• **Obstetric epidurals**




