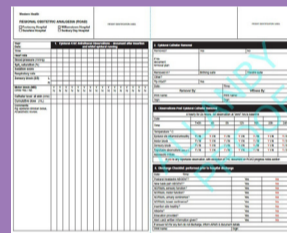
The EMR will be used for the following medication orders:

• Chemotherapy regimens



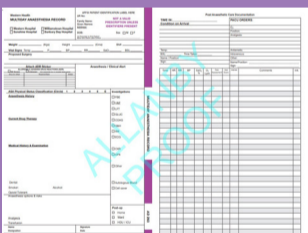
- ONC CRC Adjuvant - CAPOX (XELOX)
- ONC CRC Adjuvant - de Gramont (12 cycles)
- ONC CRC Adjuvant - FOLFOX6 (8 cycles)
- ONC CRC Advanced, Metastatic/Recurrent - pembrolizumab 3 weekly (35 cycles)
