

# Documenting Rate Changes for BAG by BAG infusions with a Variable rate – Nursing/Midwifery



## Documenting Rate Changes

1. Click on the **MAR Pending** tile to open up the **MAR Charting Window**.



2. Click on **Rate Change**

3. **Modify** the Rate change as per the order comments.

4. Enter in Second Nurse/Midwife details

5. Click **Apply**, second Nurse/Midwife enters password

6. An alert will display indicating the rate change differs from the prescribed order. Select Yes.

7. Click **Green** tick

8. Refresh the MAR and review the infusion rate change displays correctly
