All infusions must be commenced via the Medication Administration Wizard (MAW)

Commencing PCA Infusions

- 1. Check the box next to the infusion you intend to commence
- Click the yellow highlighted field under Result, the MAW Administration Window will open.
- 3. Review infusion order in Banner
- Review the Bag number (ie. Bag 1) 4.
- 5. Enter the Site of Administration
- 6. For Patient Bolus Only enter the Additive dose as 0 and select the additive dose u as per the banner (ie. MICROg/hr) & the ra will auto populate. This reflects that there no background infusion running.
- 7. Enter in Second Nurse/Midwife details
- Click OK. Second Nurse/Midwife enters 8. password, sign off Medication Administrati window.
- 9. Click refresh and check the "Begin Bag" is correct date and time on the MAR

Note: Given the rate is 0ml/hr the End Bag will appear on the right side of the MAR pending tile.

Commencement of new bag

- Record the volume infused of the bag via MAR Charting Window by clicking on the MAR Pending tile. This will be visible on the FBC via Interactive View
- 2. Repeat process for Commencing PCA Infusions

Completion of PCA

 The order will appear in grey and under the Discontinued Continuous Infusion on the MAR once the order is ceased by the APMS team.

Nurse/midwife will no longer be able to document the final volume infused on the MAR, navigate to the FBC in Interactive View, right click and insert date and time, column will appear and enter final volume.
