Reject a medication order in PharmNet.

Medication orders can be electronically rejected by pharmacists if deemed dangerous or risk to patient safety. This action places a 🐌 icon on the administration tile of the MAR to inform nurses that it has been rejected by the pharmacist and needs to be reviewed by the prescriber. There is no information or reason documented against the icon. This does not replace paging the doctor and a Pharmacy Clinical Intervention should also be documented.

*Note - A medication that has already been verified cannot be rejected

PharmNet - Rejecting a Medication Order
