

Pharmacy – Accepting a Medication Request



1. Log into EMR and view your patient list by clicking on  Pharmacy Care Organiser. Ensure correct ward list is on display

2. A number in the **Medication Request** column indicates the number of medications that have been requested for supply from pharmacy

3. Click on the number and a Process Med Request speech bubble will appear. Click on **Process Med Requests**


4. This will automatically take you to Medication Request Summary screen

5. All medication have been pre-filled to Accept, alternate option is to decline

- "Accept" is stating that the pharmacist has received/seen the request – **NOT** an indication whether or not they will be supplying the medication. It also does **NOT** indicate that a clinical check has been done
- "Decline" could be used in cases where the medication is an imprest item, use patient's own, or you have *just* supplied the medication and the person ordering is unaware.
**** Nurses will still need to check their imprest before requesting a medication****
