



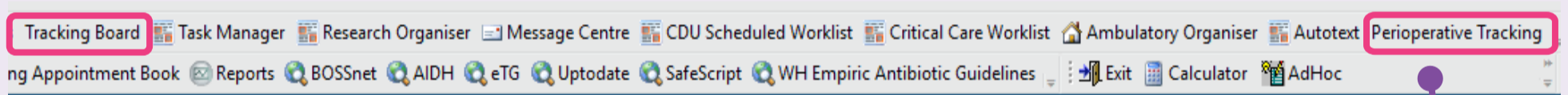
# EMR PHASE 2.1 PHARMACY KEY MESSAGES

- They enhance communication, improve patient workflow efficiency and support patient safety by providing a comprehensive and real-time overview of key patient related activities and data including patient location
