## Clinical Care - Patient has an Adrenaline Auto-injector In the Community (Medical)

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Add

- If a patient carries an Adrenaline Auto-injector in the community, it must be documented on EMR (via Problems/Alerts). This triggers an alert to prompt clinicians during each admission to ask about the auto-injector and manage accordingly
- If the patient has brought their own Adrenaline Auto-injector from home into hospital clinicians must document that the ASCIA Action Plan has been sighted (or completed) and prescribe the patient's own autoinjector as a PRN order

## Add a Problem/Alert:

- 1. Click on Dx, Problems/Alert from the Table of Contents (TOC)
- 2. Click +Add under 'Problems'
- Click Folders icon. Navigate through Common Alerts -> Medical -> Select "Meds - Patient has an adrenaline auto-injector in the community"



4. Click OK to confirm and add
