




This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to: document dermatomes

1. Click on **Interactive View and Fluid Balance** in the Table of Contents (**Menu**)



2. Click on **Adult Lines - Devices**.


Note: The **Dermatome Level** tool only appears if the **Epidural/Intrathecal** observation fields are already visible.

3. If the **Dermatome Level** and **Presence of Motor Block** tools **are** visible: there is no need to proceed with this guide. Enter the appropriate observations and **Green Tick** to save your entries.

4. If the **Dermatome Level** tool **is not** visible: proceed to step 5.

5. Click on the Customise View icon to open the **Customize** menu window.



6. Select the **Collapse All** button at the bottom of the **Customize** window.

7. Tick the **On View** box to reveal the **Epidural/Intrathecal** field for this patient, only.

8. Tick the **Default Open** box to make this the default view for all of your patients, if required.

9. Click **OK**.

10. The **Dermatome Level** and **Presence of Motor Block** fields are now visible in **Adult Lines – Devices**.

11. Enter your observations and **Green Tick** to save your entries.
