Setting a default results range

1. Navigate to the Results Review tab (1) in the Table of Contents (TOC) and select the relevant tab (2) in which you want to set a default range



- 2. Select the Options tab in the navigation tool bar at the top of the page
- From the drop-down menu select 'Properties'



- In the Properties box that displays, select the 'Defaults' tab and click on the 'Clinical Range' radio button
- Choose the desired default range in the 'Default Range Offsets' box
- 6. Click OK
- 7. Close and re-open the patient chart in order to see this change reflected
