

Filtering Anaesthesia Records on Powerchart



This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Create and apply a filter under the Documentation tab to find Anaesthesia and APS PowerNotes on Powerchart.

Definitions:

PowerNote – a structured form of clinical documentation that uses template and free text options.

Under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog, these are available for PAC/Pre-anaesthetic Assessment, Post-anaesthetic Review, Procedure Notes (for epidurals, intubation, vascular access, peripheral nerve blocks), Difficult Airway documentation.

Dynamic Documentation – a type of clinical documentation via a note with the use of Note type, note templates, auto-text and free text.



Handy Hint – PowerNotes and Dynamic Documentation can both pull data from the patient chart

e.g. medications, allergies, vital signs, pathology results, problem list.

Anaesthesia and APS PowerNotes

Under Documentation, specific PowerNotes exist under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog to document assessments, reviews and procedures:



Important – PowerNotes and Dynamic Documentation both appear under the Documentation tab but are organised under different filters


- Creating PowerNotes under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog allows easy identification of documentation of anaesthesia-related activities.
- Anaesthesia Records created in Surginet Anaesthesia (SAA) will also appear as Anaesthesia and APS notes.

1. Under Documentation, click “Advanced Filters”




2. Select “Perioperative Documents” and “Anaesthesia Records”


Select the Document Types you want to see



3. In the bottom right corner, click “Save As...”




4. Enter “Anaesthesia Records” to name the filter then click “Save”




5. In the bottom right corner, click “Close”



6. Only “Anaesthesia and APS” PowerNotes should appear:



7. To select this filter in the future, select the pre-saved “Anaesthesia Records” filter.



Important – This filter will only apply to PowerNotes under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog

- It will not filter other notes (Dynamic Documentation) or PowerNotes outside the Anaesthesia and APS catalog.
