This Quick Reference Guide will explain how to:

Create and apply a filter under the Documentation tab to find Anaesthesia and APS PowerNotes on Powerchart.

Definitions:

PowerNote – a structured form of clinical documentation that uses template and free text options. Under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog, these are available for PAC/Pre-anaesthetic Assessment, Post-anaesthetic

Review, Procedure Notes (for epidurals, intubation, vascular access, peripheral nerve blocks), Difficult Airway documentation.

Dynamic Documentation – a type of clinical documentation via a note with the use of Note type, note templates, auto-text and free text.

Handy Hint – PowerNotes and Dynamic Documentation can both pull data from the patient chart

e.g. medications, allergies, vital signs, pathology results, problem list.

Under Documentation, specific PowerNotes exist under the Anaesthesia and APS catalog to document assessments, reviews and procedures:

- Anaesthesia Records created in Surginet Anaesthesia (SAA) will also appear as Anaesthesia and APS notes.
